## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - SENIORS:

### Q. Who is running the Sunday Doubles Revolution Events and what are the objectives?

Tennis Gold Coast in association with Queens Park management.

The objectives are to:

- Connect people through an innovative doubles round robin experience that challenges players' performance and encourages them to play more.
- Explore and maximise technology that communicates with players in a fast, accurate and efficient way.
- Ensure all events are held under the auspices of the Tennis Australia code of conduct.
- Respect all and communicate honestly.
- Focus on what matters.

### Q. Who can play?

**Seniors:** Starting February 2022: Any person aged over 18 can find a doubles partner within their combined age bracket (36-100 or 101 and over) to play either the woman's, men's, or mixed doubles.

### Q. Which Entry Point and standard applies to seniors?

- PLATINUM: You have played tournaments and ladder competition for several seasons – approximate pennant & division level 1.
- GOLD: You have fixtures experience leading to finals over a period.
- SOCIAL: You have no previous tournament or fixture experience, but you are keen to give it a go.

### Q. What are the Age Brackets?

Seniors: Combined ages of 36 to 100 and 101 and over

### Q. What if I do not have a double's partner?

All entries require a partner. One of you will do the online entry and payment for both.

### Q. How do I enter?

Online entries only – See registration page

### Q. How does the scoring work?

Sunday Doubles is formatted in a doubles round robin. What is a round robin?

You will be in a pool of 4 doubles pairs, where each pair will play the other three pairs.

First to 6 games wins the set and thus the match. Tiebreak will be at five all.

A short deuce will be played: This means that at the first deuce, whoever wins the next point, wins the game.

### Q. Will there be any prizes at the end of your Round Robin event?

First Prize: The winning Team of your Event and Age bracket wins a \$35 sport voucher each.

### Q. What is the price to enter?

Entry is \$25 per person. One of you will do the online entry and payment for both.

Limited spaces available – enrol early

### Q. How do I win the \$1000 at the BIG HIT CHALLENGE?

**BIG HIT:** There is \$1,000 to be won by any player who knocks over a can of balls. Each \$1000.00 BIG HIT will take place over four Sundays. If more than one players hits the can over the four Sundays, the money is divided equally and payable after the fourth Sunday.

**HOW DOES IT WORK:** At the completion of a round robin event, each player will individually be invited by the Supervisor to (one at a time) have one serve only from the baseline to knock over a tin of balls placed anywhere on the service line at the other end of the court. Each player's serve must be confirmed by phone video taken by a supervisor present. Prior to serving, the player have to look at the camera and state their full name. The player can then proceed with the serve. Any player compromising this process in any way e.g. having multiple serves, serving before camera is operating, will be ineligible to win.

**PRIZE MONEY:** A new \$1000.00 is on offer for every four Sundays in the year's event schedule. If more than one players hits the can over the four Sundays, the money is divided equally and payable after the fourth Sunday. Successful players will asked to provide banking details for payment transfer.

**Q. What do I bring?**

Comfortable enclosed tennis shoes, sports attire, a hat, water bottle and racquet (2 new balls will be provided per court). Refreshments will be available to purchase from the Pro Shop.

**Q. Who will oversee the play and matches?**

There will be supervisors roaming the courts and they can be consulted at any time.

**Q. How do I qualify for the end of year Finals?**

Each event you play you will accrue points – 100 points for a win (each), 70 points for second (each), 40 points for third (each) and 25 points for fourth (each).

Your best three results during the year will be added to determine an invitation to the FINALS play-offs in November.

**Q. What are the Dates of the Events?**

Twelve Sundays are reserved on the Tennis Gold Coast calendar.

## Q. Who is running the Sunday Doubles Revolution Events and what are the objectives?

- **Tennis Gold Coast introduces the new “Coach Can” initiative Following the Davis Cup style, one coach per team is allowed to sit on court with the two players and discuss tactics and strategy at change overs.**

- Explore and maximise technology that communicates with players in a fast, accurate and efficient way.

## Q. Who can play?

**Juniors:** Starting June 2022: Girls and Boys only (no mixed).

## Q. What are the Age Brackets?

Juniors: 14–17-year-old and 13 and under.

## Q. What if I do not have a double’s partner?

All entries require a partner. A guardian/parent does the online entry and payment for both.

## Q. How do I enter?

Online entries only – See registration page

## Q. How does the scoring work?

Sunday Doubles is formatted in a doubles round robin. What is a round robin?

You will be in a pool of 4 doubles pairs, where each pair will play the other three pairs.

First to 6 games wins the set and thus the match. Tiebreak will be at five all.

A short deuce will be played: This means that at the first deuce, whoever wins the next point, wins the game.

## Q. How do I win the BIG HIT CHALLENGE - JUNIORS?

**HOW DOES IT WORK:** At the completion of a round robin event, each player will individually be invited by the Supervisor to (one at a time) have one serve only from the baseline to knock over a tin of balls placed anywhere on the service line at the other end of the court. Each player’s serve must be confirmed by phone video taken by a supervisor present. Prior to serving, the player have to look at the camera and state their full name. The player can then proceed with the serve. Any player compromising this process in any way e.g. having multiple serves, serving before camera is operating, will be ineligible to win.

**PRIZE VOUCHER:** The \$300.00 sports voucher is awarded to the successful player/s at the end of the year (in the case of multi winners the amount is divided equally).

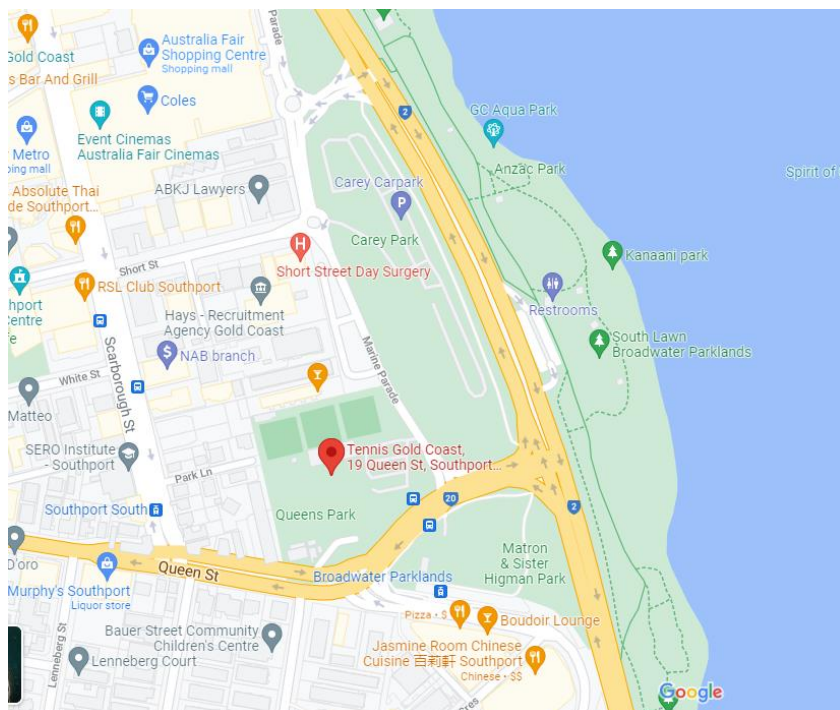
